THE OPPORTUNITY: Controller

Calgary Health Foundation is looking for a detail-oriented and results-driven finance professional to join our team. As our Controller, you will lead the day-to-day functions of the Finance team, including finance, accounting, reporting and analysis, budgeting, audit, and regulatory compliance activities.

Key accountabilities of the role include:

- Overseeing financial management and reporting functions, including general ledger entries, monthly investment accounting, and preparation of financial statements, ensuring accuracy and timely completion for quarter-end and annual reporting.
- **Leading the annual audit process**, ensuring all working papers and financial statements are prepared for auditors, while ensuring ongoing compliance with all provincial, federal, and regulatory reporting requirements.
- Preparing the annual budget and quarterly forecasts, coordinating department budgets and collaborating with department heads to project revenue and expenses.
- Developing and implementing internal controls in collaboration with the CFO, while maintaining financial system integrity (Financial Edge NXT).
- Continuously improving financial processes and reporting to ensure process optimization and compliance with regulatory standards.
- Directly managing the finance team by setting goals, reviewing performance, providing mentorship, cross-training, and offering backup support as needed to foster professional growth and effective team performance.

The ideal candidate has a strong background in accounting and financial management, with direct experience overseeing general ledger functions, financial reporting, and budgeting. Possessing in-depth knowledge of compliance regulations, audit processes, and financial systems, and a proven track record of developing and implementing effective internal controls, the successful incumbent will utilize their strong leadership and communications skills to manage and develop a finance team with a focus on continuous improvement and process optimization.
